

# SUPPORT THE 2015 HOMECOMING RUN FOR AUTISM!



The Center for Autism and Related Disabilities (CARD) at Florida Atlantic University and Campus Recreation will hold the Homecoming 5K Run/Walk for Autism on Sunday, October 25 at 5:30 p.m. at the FAU Boca campus Track and Field Complex.

More than 1,400 runners and walkers will take their mark with a goal to raise \$20,000. This fundraiser helps support the services that FAU CARD provides to the community, including scholarships for children to receive social skills treatment, funds to provide travel to local schools and homes to train families and teachers, and screenings in CARD's mobile clinic.

The 5K certified course is the only local event that routes runners through the state-of-the art FAU Football Stadium. The fee to participate is \$30 for pre-registration through October 21 and \$35 to register on race day. Participation for anyone under 18 years of age is \$15. Currently enrolled FAU students are free, but must pre-register at [www.fau.edu/campusrec](http://www.fau.edu/campusrec) by October 21 at noon. Awards will be given to the top three male and female runners in several age categories.

A Family Fun Run & Walk around the FAU track will begin at 5 p.m. This run/walk is non-competitive with a \$15 fee to participate or \$10 for anyone age 16 or under. A Kid's Run for ages 8 and under is free. Children may also enjoy a bounce house and an opportunity to paint the CARD mobile clinic. Food and beverages will be available for all participants, as well as t-shirts for all pre-registered participants in the 5K Run/Walk and one-mile Fun Run. Families impacted by autism will have the opportunity to check out local service providers and get important information!
