## **Dublin, Ireland**

June 3 – June 18, 2017

Study abroad in the "Emerald Isle" this summer. The River Liffey divides the city into two distinct areas, both of which have seen an upswing in recent years. But as Joyce, Yeats, Swift, and their modern counterparts have eloquently demonstrated, every corner pub, emerald green, and Georgian square of Ireland's largest city holds a story waiting to be shared.

Academic Program: This summer program is a College of Education Graduate study abroad program offered by the Department of Curriculum, Culture, and Educational Inquiry. The course has been designed to engage the learner in a comparative investigation of educational trends and issues in the USA, Ireland, and other European countries. Learners will participate in numerous field experience activities at European sites selected by the learner to support and enhance the cultural exchange component of this unique experience. The academic offering is a Directed Independent Study format that includes telecommuting pre and post international experience, as well as on-site tutorials with the professor in addition to a research component.

**Eligibility Requirements**: Program is open to graduate students from any discipline with a 3.0 GPA or higher. (Exceptions to the 3.0 GPA requirements may be possible for graduate students, please contact program leader, Dr. Weber for more information.)

Course Description: EDG 6625 Global Perspectives - Ireland (3 credit hours)

This course focuses on comparing, analyzing, and evaluating curricular trends, issues, pedagogy, and resources in education systems in developing and industrialized nations, and implications for national and global citizenship in the 21st century.

**Program Fee:** \$485

<u>Program Fee Includes</u>: Application fee, group expenses, CISI insurance, predeparture orientation, and on-site support staff.

**Program Fee Does Not Include**: FAU tuition (in-state/out-of-state rates apply), airfare, local transportation, accommodations, meals, cell phone, and spending money. Students make all arrangements after consultation with the professor. Total cost is estimated at \$2,868 (not including tuition).

Application Deadline: EXTENDED: March 16, 2017 or as space permits Apply online through <a href="https://www.fau.fluidreview.com">www.fau.fluidreview.com</a> and pay the \$100 application fee.

**Financial Aid:** Students may be able to use their financial aid for study abroad. The amount of the financial aid awarded and its availability will be determined by the Office of Financial Aid. Students need to have a current FAFSA on file and complete a summer Financial Aid Application in order to apply for funding. Summer financial aid requires that students be registered for a total of 6 credits.
